About our publications:

Matters of Substance is a resource for teachers or others who work with school students. It is aimed at mid secondary school, and contains information and activities to accompany classroom drug and alcohol education. Each edition is compiled using feedback and requests from the previous publications.

Triple S of Drugs: Signs, Side Effects & Strategies is a teacher resource kit for use with lower secondary students. It shows linked curriculum elements, and contains full orientation and instructions for three classroom activity based lessons, with activity templates, guidance... and answers.

Side Effects Scramble is one of the activities which form part of Triple S: it is an activity kit with instructions and orientation. All materials are provided.

Hear Your Peer is a discussion based activity for groups within the classroom. It is also part of Triple S. The kit provides all materials including instructions and orientation.

Just The Facts is a research and processing activity for classroom based lessons for upper secondary students. A full set of instructions (including teacher cheat-sheet) and resource list is provided. Resources can be borrowed from the Resource Centre if not available at the school.

Attitudes is a discussion based activity for groups within the classroom for upper secondary students. The kit provides all materials including instructions and orientation.

Drugs - What and Why? is a teacher resource kit for use with upper primary students. It shows linked curriculum elements, and contains full orientation and instructions for three classroom activity based lessons, with activity templates, guidance... and answers. The lessons: **Decision Maker**, **Drugs-Why Do It?** and **Effects Jigsaw** are also available separately.

Spent is a collection of young people's stories about their addiction to heroin. It is a powerful resource that speaks directly to its audience, pulling no punches. *Rated M due to language and drug issues

What's The Score is an interactive CD-Rom for young people to explore choices and consequences around drug use.

FAQ from Schools is a collation of the questions fired at our educators in schools – as they are asked – with answers directed at young people.
